Comprehensive new TLCC user courses available for Lotus Notes and Domino 6.5

Boca Raton, FL, September 22 2003 – IBM Lotus Notes 6.5 users can now upgrade their Lotus Notes and Domino skills – right at their home or office computer – with TLCC's two new distance learning courses for Lotus Notes 6.5 users.

The first course, Using Lotus Notes 6.5, is for users who have never used Lotus Notes before. The second course, Lotus Notes R5 to Notes 6.5 Update, is for users moving from Lotus Notes R5 to Lotus Notes 6.5.

Both courses avoid boring simulations by offering extensive activities and demonstrations done right in the Lotus Notes 6.5 client. TLCC's interactive, hands-on user courses offer the following features:

- **Runs on Lotus Notes and Domino** - TLCC courses do not simulate the Lotus Notes environment.
